Senior Hunger Ministries/Charities

Meals on Wheels of Cherokee County

Cherokee County Meals On Wheels was founded in May of 1984 to meet a definite need among the elderly and handicapped of our county. Today they serve more than 400 people with the help of more than 300 volunteers. Their budget for 2005 was \$203,000, all of which came from donations. They receive no government funding and do not charge clients.

Mobile Meals of Spartanburg County

Mobile Meals of Spartanburg began on October 3, 1977, serving 25 meals with 15 volunteers. Today they serve nearly 2000 residents with approximately 150 volunteers each weekday. Mobile Meals is an independent 501-C3 non-profit organization which depends on contributions from businesses, churches, foundations, and individuals to meet an annual budget of more than 2 million dollars.

Union County Council on Aging

A home-delivered meals program administered through Meals on Wheels, a private non-profit agency. The Division on Aging serves home delivered meals and brings in to their centers Union County residents who, because of illness or physical disability are unable to provide their own meals.

Union Meals on Wheels

A fully volunteer-operated ministry that serves 120 meals per day to residents of Buffalo and Union who, because of illness or physical disability, are unable to provide their own meals.
